



We are pleased to once again host a clinic With Geoff Teall, April 27th-29th, 2012

Geoff has been involved with the horse industry for over 35 years. He has trained hunter and equitation Champions at such shows as Lake Placid, South Hampton, WEF, Capitol Challenge, Devon, Harrisburg, Washington, and the National Horse Show. He holds an "R" rating for judging hunters and equitation, and has judged at most major hunter shows. He has been very active in governance in the USEF and USHJA, as well as serving on the Trainer's Certification program, High Performance Hunter, and Planning and Rule Change Committees.

We will be holding 3 sessions, daily for the three days. There will be a 2'6" section, a 3' section, and a 3'3" and higher section. The focus will be on both Hunters and Equitation, but jumper riders should consider this an opportunity for a great lesson with a great trainer! This is a USHJA sponsored clinic.

The fee for the clinic is \$650 for the weekend. A rider can ride on individual days, @\$225 per day, but are encouraged to ride the whole weekend! A \$200 deposit is required of all participants. Auditors are encouraged and welcome, \$40 per day. Each rider may have 1 free auditor.

Our arena is a spacious 80' x 200', with a large selection of jumps. We have excellent footing, heated/air conditioned viewing rooms, and heated aisles. We have a limited number of stalls available for students who wish to ship in, but they go fast, so please reserve in advance!
